CLOTHING/GEAR

Flashlight/Headlamp

This location is well suited for extra wide lenses (ex: 11-24mm, 10-22mm). If you have one of these lenses, bring it along. If you do not own one, your 16-35 will work just fine!

We recommend that you bring a back-up camera with you to Banff. Too many times we have seen cameras fail in the field. There are no stores that have camera equipment nearby, so please come prepared.

Temperatures average between 40-60F degrees this time of year. You should be prepared for cool mornings or wet weather. Please bring clothing that will allow you to layer for changes in temperature and weather in the field. Hiking boots are strongly encouraged. We will also be photographing around many lakes. If you have a pair of wellies or water boots, bring them along.

*It is not necessary for you to bring your computer with you to participate. We will have processing class, but you can follow along with the instructor's computer should you choose not to carry one.

PLEASE NOTE: Not all items mentioned above are necessary for your photo workshop. If you do not have an item listed, there is no need to purchase it to participate. This is a place where you will learn from instructors and other participants about equipment preferences.
