

The following items are recommendations for your upcoming CAMARGUE photo workshop. Please note that most items are not necessary for you to participate in the workshop, but we encourage you to bring them if you own them. If you do not own items on this list there is no need to purchase them. We will be photographing horses, birds, landscapes and villages.

#### LENSES FOR THE HORSES

Last year, I brought and used a 300mm prime lens for the horses. I found the lens that I used the most was my wide angle. This year, I will bring a 100-400mm lens. The horses begin running from a distance, but they run fast. Having the ability to zoom will help you to get more photographs. We will position our tripods and cameras with larger telephoto lenses to capture the horses running. I wear a  $2^{\text{nd}}$  camera body with a lens strap over my shoulder that has a wide angle lens attached. This way I can capture images when the horses get close.

I always recommend carrying a back-up camera in the field. I have seen even the newest cameras fail from time to time. If you do not have a second camera body, see if you can borrow one from a friend, or consider renting one for the workshop at either lensrentals.com or borrowlenses.com

It is very important that you bring extra batteries. If you are using a mirrorless camera, your battery life is even shorter. Please consider purchasing or borrowing extra batteries.

Europe use different plugs for electronics. Please bring a converter and adapters. These can be purchased at travel sections in most big stores.

\*It is not necessary for you to carry a laptop to the workshop. You will want a method of backing up your images. If your camera holds two memory cards, you can back-up using this method. If you carry a portable external hard drive, please bring the cord that connects your camera to the drive for back-up.
