PHOTO EQUIPMENT

- Camera Body
- 2nd Camera Body
- Grizzly Bean Bag

Please note that tripods are **not** easily used. Some people like to use monopods, but a bean bag will give you the best results.



Medium size is best. Bring empty. We will fill it in Africa.

LENSES

- Telephoto Lens (500-600mm range)
- Telephoto Lens (100-400mm range)
- Wide Angle Lens (24-105mm range)

FILTERS

TECHNOLOGY

- Computer
- Charging Cable
- External Drive

MISC

- Extra Batteries
- Battery Charger
- Power Adapter for Country of Safari
- Extra Memory Cards
- Lens Cloth

It is not necessary for you to bring your computer, but you will want a method of backing up your photos.

CLOTHING

- Quick Dry Shirts (3 recommended)
- Quick Dry Pants (3 recommended)
- Tees (2 recommended)
- Jacket (cool mornings)
- Undergarments
- Socks
- Pajamas
- Hiking Shoes or Boots
- Sandals or Casual Shoe for after hours
- Hat
- Sunglasses

REMINDER Pack light. Domestic and/or chartered flights have luggage size and weight restrictions. Laundry services are available at most camps for a small fee.

TOILETRIES

- Sunscreen
- Lip Balm
- Moisturizer
- Bug Spray
- RX's (US prescriptions are not available in Africa)
- Pain Reliever
- Dramamine (motion sickness)
- Imodium / Anti-diarrheal
- Hydration Packs for Water
