PROCESSING

Laptop and Power Cord
Card Reader

MISC ITEMS

Cleaning Cloths
Batteries and Charger
Memory Cards

CLOTHING/GEAR

Rain Jacket & Pants or Windbreaker
Layers for changing temps
Hiking boots
Hat
Gloves
Flashlight / Headlamp

You should always be prepared for cold or wet weather. Please bring clothing that will allow you to layer for changes in temperature and weather in the field. This is a very remote location without quick access to gear stores or Amazon.
